

Notice of U.S. Government Regulations

For Purchase of Thermal Imaging Products

Pelco thermal imaging cameras, including Esprit Ti, are subject to U.S. government export control regulations. As such, Pelco has established the following policies to ensure our compliance with these government regulations regarding the export and potential resale of thermal imaging products.

- *All* customers purchasing Pelco thermal imaging cameras, regardless of the shipping destination, must complete a form BIS 711 (Statement by Ultimate Consignee and Purchaser) at the time an order is placed. This form can be accessed at <http://www.bis.doc.gov/licensing/bis711.pdf>

Pelco will maintain a copy of this completed form on file at Pelco Headquarters in Clovis, California.

- An export license is necessary for *all 25hz and 30hz* model cameras shipped outside the U.S. or Canada. In cooperation with the customer, Pelco will manage the U.S. Federal Government export license application process prior to product shipment. Average license application time is 30-60 days. If you have any questions about the license application process, please contact exportcontrol@pelco.com.
- In compliance with U.S. government export control regulations, only cameras that have been installed in the U.S. or Canada are eligible for advance replacement. All other cameras must be returned to Pelco before a replacement will be shipped.

NOTE: Pelco is not responsible for the re-sale, or transfer of ownership by any other method, of Pelco thermal imaging cameras from the Ultimate Consignee designated on the BIS 711 statement to another party. *It is the responsibility of the Ultimate Consignee to comply with all applicable export regulations.* Additional information regarding U.S. export regulations can be found at www.bis.doc.gov.
